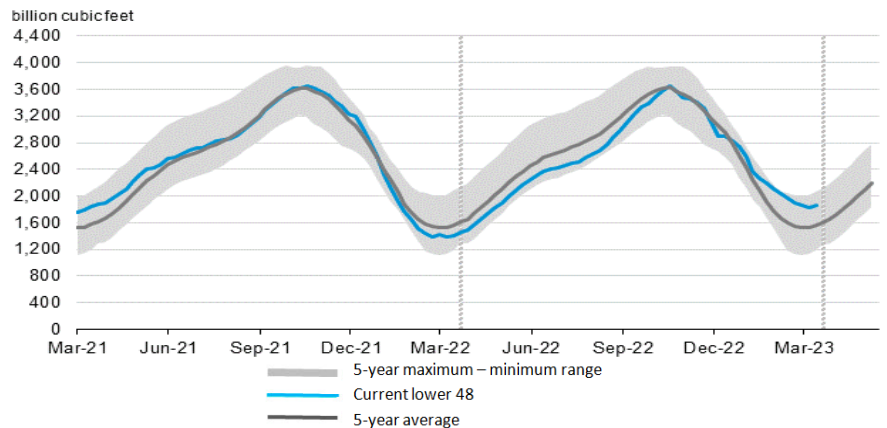

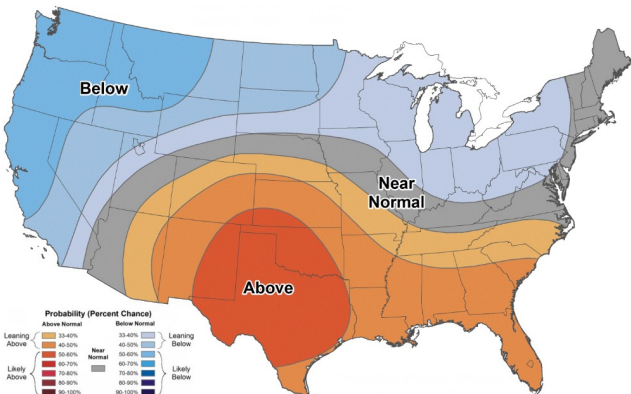

Working Gas in Storage Compared to 5-Year Range



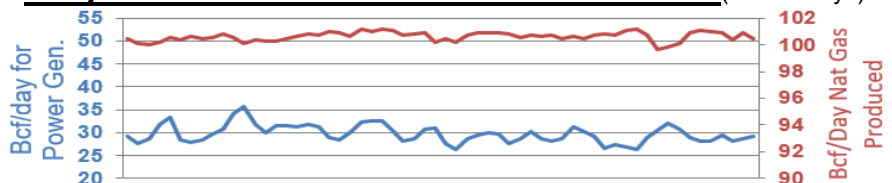
Temperature Forecast Apr 21 through Apr 27, 2023
