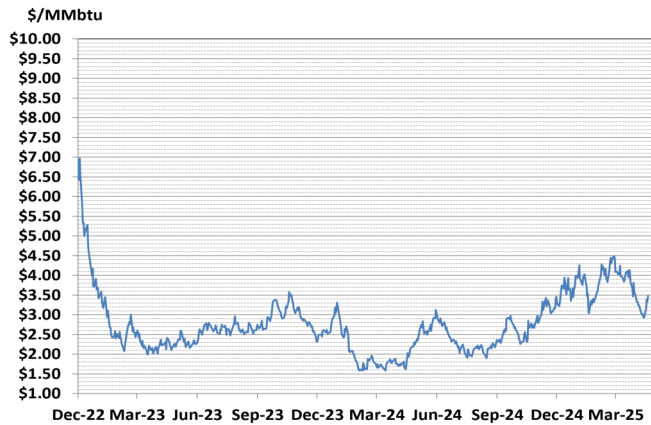

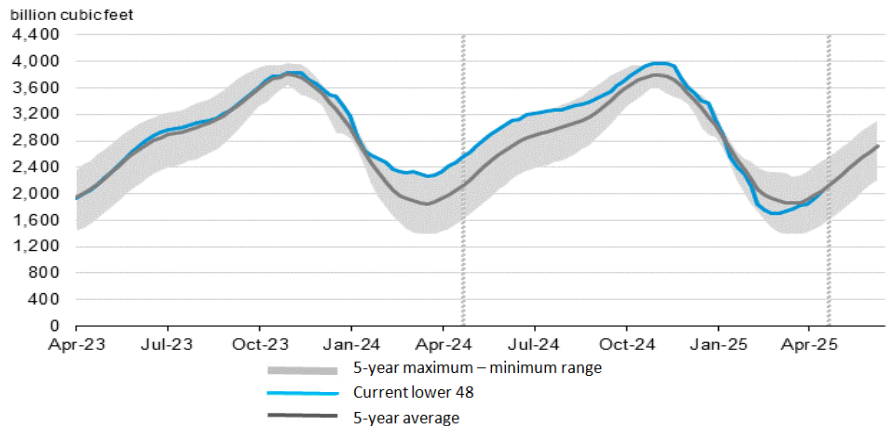

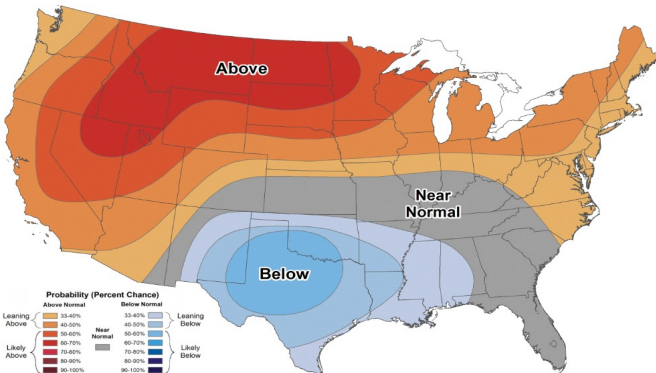

Working Gas in Storage Compared to 5-Year Range



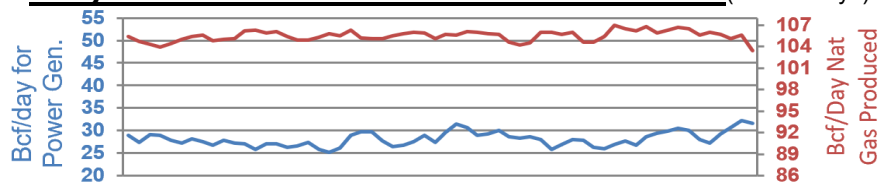
Temperature Forecast May 09, 2025 through May 15, 2025
