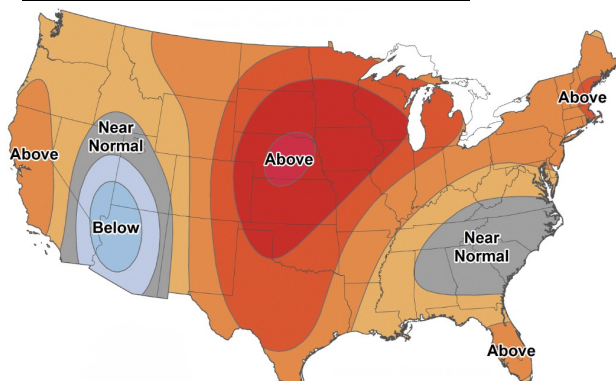
Near-Month Natural Gas

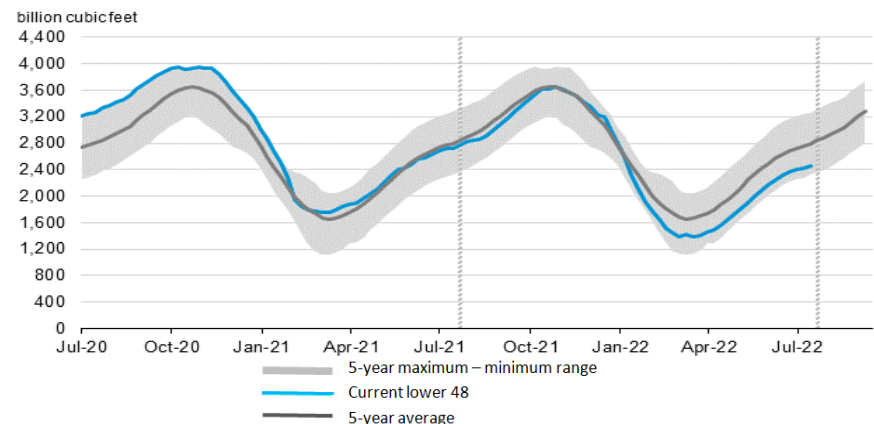

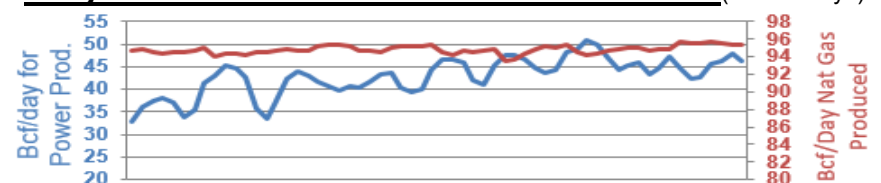
